

Re: Philadelphia Mayoral Democratic Primary Polling Update

With the Democratic primary election for Philadelphia Mayor just weeks away, new Data for Progress polling fielded from April 26 to 29th shows a close race between Helen Gym and Rebecca Rhynhart, both leading at 21 percent, with Cherelle Parker at 19 percent, Allan Domb at 13 percent, Jeff Brown at 9 percent, and undecided voters in the double-digits.



While the race is close, of voters reporting they are "definitely voting for their candidate," Gym leads Rhynhart by four percentage points and Parker by eight percentage points. Rhynhart and Parker both also have a higher percentage of voters who are "still considering their options" when asked about their level of support. Additionally, the highest rate of voters still undecided are those under 40 years old, a demographic Gym leads.

Methodology:

From April 26 to 29, 2023, Data for Progress conducted a survey of 560 likely Democratic primary voters in Philadelphia using SMS and web panel respondents. The sample was weighted to be representative of likely voters by age, gender, education, race, geography, and voting history. The survey was conducted in English. The margin of error is ± 4 percentage points.
